Dear Friends and Supporters,

Community Reach Center's legacy is built upon a steadfast commitment to provide life-changing services that support wellness for all ages. Throughout the past 65+ years, the agency has achieved many "firsts" in Colorado: the first behavioral health agency to implement school-based therapy programs in public schools; first to launch an electronic health record system; and first to acquire a pediatric primary care practice that supports comprehensive integrated care for children. Innovations like these are developed by a staff comprised of some of the most talented clinicians and administrators in the field. The COVID pandemic has challenged us to develop new approaches to maintain seamless connection with current clients and ensure easy access for new clients seeking treatment. Retaining talented staff to accommodate all available service delivery options is key to meeting the needs of our community. Workforce challenges that are being felt across the country has created situations in which we have had to temporarily discontinue programs we could not staff to assure our consumers and community we are laser focused on providing the highest quality of services.

In 2021 the agency implemented a variety of recruitment strategies such as virtual job fairs, sign-on bonuses and compensation for relocation expenses and in 2022 we increased our minimum wage to reflect a livable wage, tuition reimbursement, generous overnight shift differentials and much more. Staff enjoys a supportive culture at Community Reach that provides weekly video communications with the leadership team, pathways for professional development and continuing education opportunities. Now more than ever, we are committed to maintaining an investment in the growth and well-being of our staff because we know that investment supports the best treatment experience possible for our clients.

On behalf of the staff and board members of Community Reach, we are pleased to present the 2022 Annual Report.

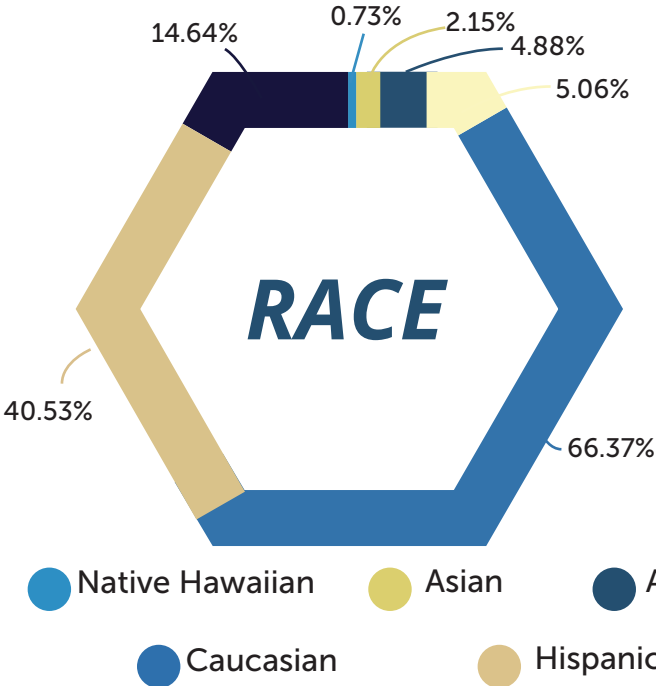

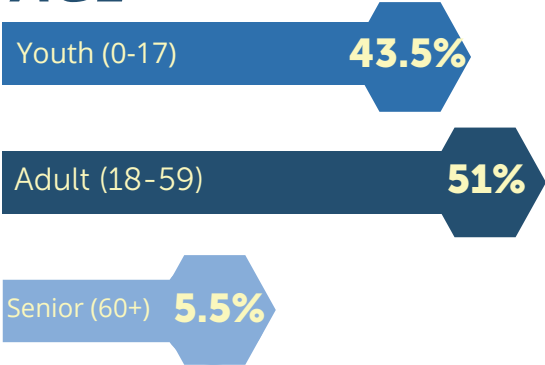

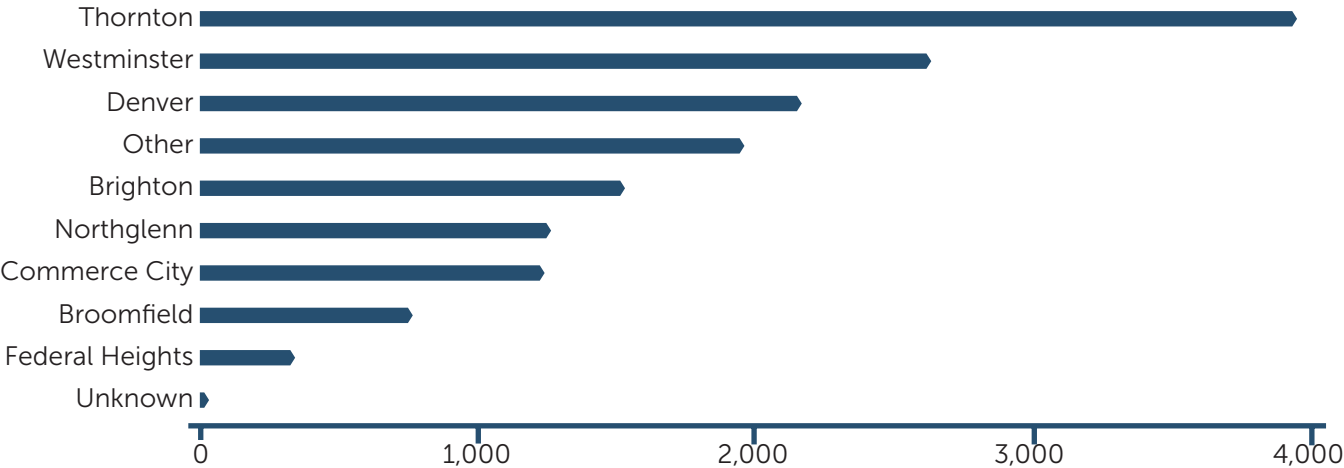

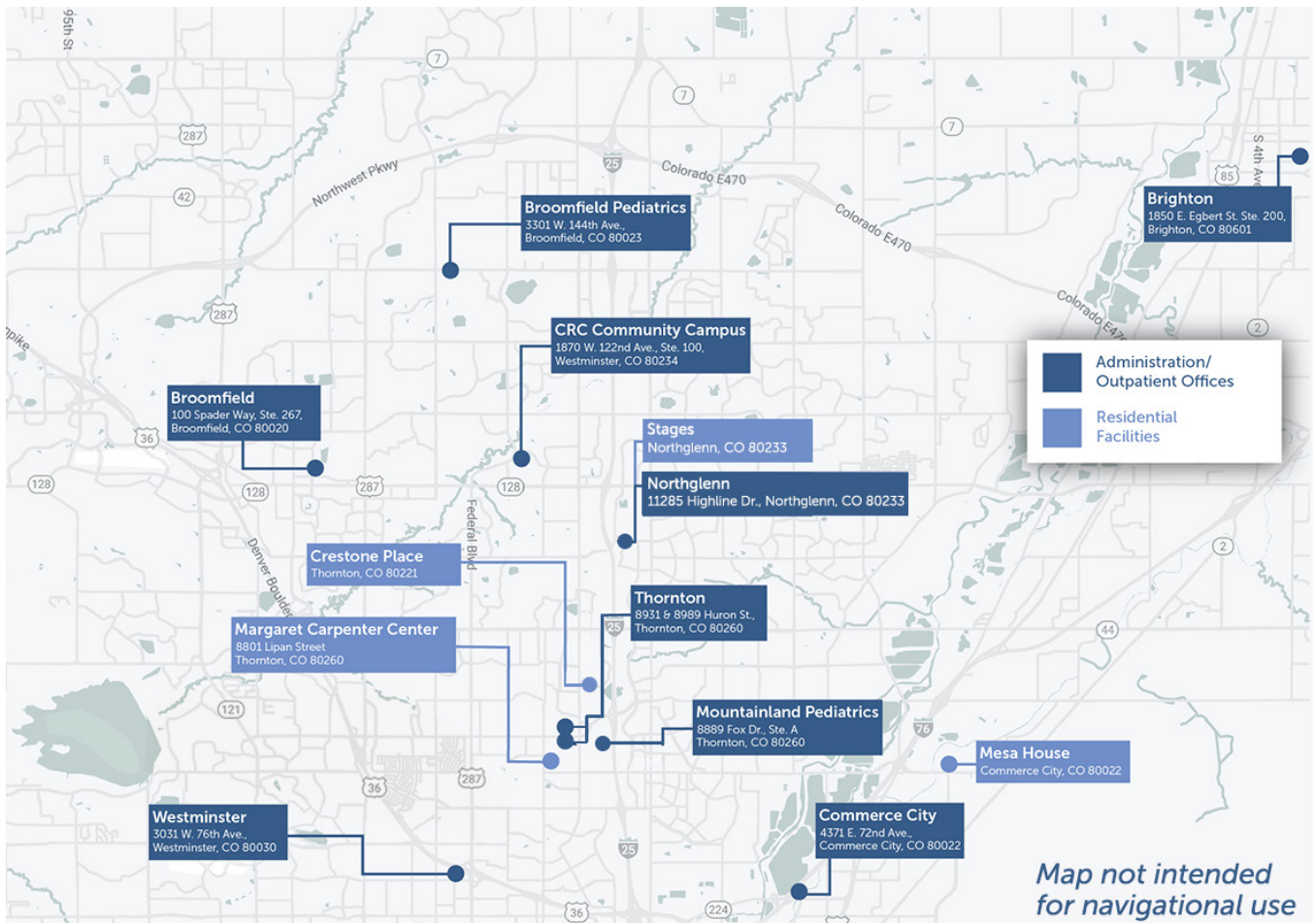
